

OKLAHOMA ASSOCIATION OF STUDENT COUNCILS SUMMER BASIC LEADERSHIP WORKSHOP

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR STUDENT DELEGATES:

1. **MEALS-** Meals will be provided from Sunday evening through Friday morning of the workshop. You will be given a meal band that must be worn at all times.
2. **PERSONAL CARS-** Students must park their cars after they have arrived and unpacked. The cars are to remain parked until departure for home. OASC will not assume any responsibility for accidents, injury, or damage caused by your driving your car to and from the workshop. The OASC is not responsible for any damage you might cause to the University property by you or your car.
3. **SUBSTITUTES-** If, for some reason, you cannot attend the Workshop, CONTACT YOUR LOCAL SCHOOL ADVISOR who may make arrangements for a substitute (must substitute the same gender)--Substitution fee charge is \$25. The ADVISOR must secure a workshop registration form and a health form for the substitute. **The Advisor must email the BASIC Registrar (Janet Carter) at: janet.carter@sulphur12.org**
4. **EXTRA MONIES** (*optional expenses* that might be incurred by a typical delegate) Additional snacks or money for the student store at NWOSU. Each delegate will receive a BASIC T-shirt but others may be sold during the week.
5. **ROOM KEY- A \$20.00 deposit** for your room key is required when checking in to the dorm. Upon departure, when the key is returned, the deposit is returned. If you lose your key, you will forfeit your deposit. (Delegates may use their \$20 deposit to buy a BASIC DVD)
6. **EMERGENCY PHONE CALLS-**The 24 hour OASC BASIC phone number, **918-629-2980**, will give you immediate contact with the OASC Workshop Directors. Delegates can also easily be reached for EMERGENCIES by calling this number
